THEME VERSE

Isaiah 43:18-19 (NKJV)

TWEETABLE MOMENTS:

“Jesus came to be the welcome mat of your life! If He replaces your sin, God is welcome to reign in you!”

“We have allowed satan to use our life as a playground too long.”

“JESUS comes to the forgotten.”

“When Mary turned, we turned. When Mary turned that’s when the world turned.”

Start with an icebreaker question to get everyone talking. Then choose questions that will work well with your group.

1. Is there any part of the Easter story that is hard for you to believe? (Jesus died, rose from the grave, and came back to life)
2. Have you ever attempted to prove what Jesus did to others like John did? How did that go?
3. When was the last time you RAN towards Jesus like John and Peter did?
4. What personal demons prevent you from telling others about Jesus?
5. How do you react when a friend tells you about their encounter with the Lord as Mary Magdalene did with the disciples? Do you believe them or are you doubtful?
6. What was going through your head when you walked over the Jesus rug as you left the sanctuary?

To introduce some different perspectives into the conversation, consider reading one of these verses together.

John 20:1-18 (NKJV)

John 19:34 (NKJV)

John 20:31 (NKJV)

Luke 8:2 (NKJV)

End each week with a challenge to take action. Guide your group and help each person identify their next steps.
