### THEME VERSE

#### Isaiah 43:18-19 (NKJV)

"Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."

#### TWEETABLE MOMENTS:

"God is the God of "I am" and "I will". Will you?"

"Don't mess around and mistake the prophet for the providential in your life."

"Stop looking on the external and dig on the internal for the oil that's on the inside."

"If you won't be sent I question how the value you place on what you hold."

**Start with an icebreaker question to get everyone talking. Then choose questions that will work well with your group.**

1. We are to behold God but we are also to be sent out for Him. This is much harder. Share some ways you have been sent in the past.
2. What failure in your life has God flipped into a victory?
3. Remember the position the widow was in in 2 Kings 4:1-7. Instead of becoming immobilized during a pressing season, what are some things we can do personally to get through them? What are some things we can do as a Talk It Out Group to get through them.
4. Who are the right people for you to connect with during a pressing season?
5. If this is true for you then SAY "I AM a Christian". Now let's put it into action and fill in the blank...I WILL \_\_\_\_\_. What is God asking you do do? Where is He sending you? Don't get trapped in what you've done in the past for the Lord. He is a God of now.
6. How did it make you feel when Pastor Shawn said if you are unwilling to be sent then he questions how much you place value on what you hold?

**To introduce some different perspectives into the conversation, consider reading one of these verses together.**

2 Kings 4:1-7 (NKJV)
